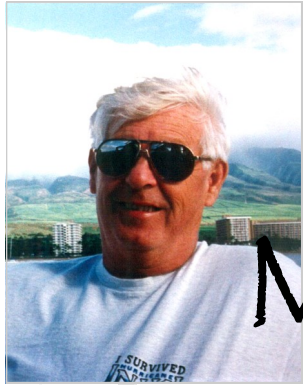

Directions to Kahala Kai Catamaran at Kewalo Basin

For Memorial Service of John Doe

From **Waikiki** take Ala Moana Blvd west toward downtown & airport. At Ward Avenue make a U-turn. At the first light headed back make a right turn into the harbor.

There will be metered parking, (\$0.50/hour) immediately off to your left. You will see a booth on the corner of the front row with a jet ski on the roof. If you are taking a cab have the driver pull up between the front row of vessels and second wharf labeled A Wharf. Kahala Kai will be tied up at this loading area 15 minutes before your sailing time.

From **West Oahu & North Shore**, Oahu, take H-1 East. Take the Kinau exit. Turn right at the first light onto Ward Avenue and head down the hill a few lights. At Ala Moana Blvd turn left and go down one light and turn right into the harbor and follow the bold directions above.

From **Kahala Resort, Hawaii Kai & East Oahu**, take H-1 West. Take the Lunalilo exit. Go the second light which is Ward Avenue and turn left and head down the hill a few lights. At Ala Moana Blvd turn left and go toward Waikiki one light and turn right into the harbor and follow the bold directions above.

From **Kailua, Kaneohe and Windward** side of Oahu, take the Pali or Like-like Highway over the Ko'olau Mountains. Take the H-1 East exit and head east. Take the Kinau exit. Turn right at the first light onto Ward Avenue and head down the hill a few lights. At Ala Moana Blvd turn left and go down one light and turn right into the harbor and follow the bold directions above.
